

Ad-Vance Engineering in dash to manufacture vital medical equipment in fight against Covid 19 virus



Ad-Vance Engineering have been appointed to manufacture the tooling for a 2-piece low cost face shield that can be used as PPE for front-line NHS medical staff in their battle against the Covid19 virus.

Working with local designers and injection moulding partners they will immediately begin production on a tool for moulding a quick-assembly face mask comprising a front shield made from acetate/PET, that will be fog resistant and that simply clips on to hooks on the brim.

Local Health and Social Care Trusts have indicated the need for initial delivery of at least 300,000 units right away with the potential to supply front-line staff across the wider NHS and HSE in the Republic of Ireland.

Roger Vance, managing director of Ad-Vance Engineering stated the company will be rigorously adhering to all the essential guidance and protocols issued by the government, [Public Health Agency](#) and [World Health Organisation](#) to keep everyone safe from Covid-19.
