

Excel Precision Group Continues to Grow its Network of UK Branches as well as Continuing to Invested in the Latest Technology

Since January 2019, Excel Precision Group has invested over £1.2m in new machines and new technology. The addition of five new Sodick wire and spark erosion machines at our Gloucester and Leeds branches has seen our capacity increase by over 35% as we replace old technology with new.

The acquisition of Sheen Spark Ltd in Birmingham, a NADCAP and AS9110 Rev D accredited company now rebranded “Excel Precision (Birmingham) Ltd.” is the latest development in our overriding strategy of having sub-contract EDM machine shops throughout the UK servicing the local manufacturing and engineering communities.
